



Centurion & Supreme Boats, in conjunction with the Competitive Wake Surf Association, is proud to announce the criteria* to qualify for an invitation to compete in the **26th Annual World Wake Surfing Championship**

Event Dates

- **Live Venue:** October 6 to 8, 2022
 - Live Venue Skill Levels: All
 - **All North American** competitors must attend the Live venue to compete in this event
 - Must attend onsite check and mandatory Riders Meeting on **October 5**
 - Opening Ceremony Live Venue: Each day of the Live venue event, specific time TBD
- **Module Venues:** September 15 to 19, 2022
 - Module Venue Skill Levels: All
 - Any **non-North American** competitor who **cannot** travel to the Live venue due to COVID related travel restrictions may compete via a Module venue in lieu of the Live venue
 - Live venue attendance is preferred for ALL competitors
 - Mandatory Riders Meeting – Video – Deadline for Compliance is September 13

Event Location East coast, United States

Event Attendance & Competition Requirement **This event is Invitation only.** To qualify for an invitation to the most prestigious Wake Surfing event on the planet an athlete must attend and compete in the following minimum number of World Series of Wake Surfing events (Gold or Platinum Event Level), and the athlete’s Continental Championship (North American, European or Asian Wake Surfing Championship) event:

- a. Pro Skill Level Three (3) 2022 World Series of Wake Surfing events (Gold or Platinum Level), **and** the athlete’s 2022 Continental Championship. If the Continental Championship is a Gold or Platinum Level event, it will count as one of the required three (3) World Series events.
- b. All Other Skill Levels Two (2) 2022 World Series of Wake Surfing events (Gold or Platinum Level), **and** the 2022 Continental Championship. If the Continental Championship is a Gold or Platinum Level event, it will count as one of the required two (2) World Series events.
- c. There is no WRS Qualified event (Bronze or Silver Event Level) competition or attendance requirement, however, all WRS Qualified event points are included in the WRS Rankings.
- d. The Event Attendance and Competition Requirement may be met in any Skill Level during the 2022 season.
- e. If an athlete meets the Event Attendance and Competition Requirement for one Division in their Skill Level, the requirement will be met for the other Division in that Skill Level.

Invitation Criteria In addition to meeting the event attendance requirement, an athlete must be in the top WRS Ranked range in any below listed Division, as of the Qualification Cutoff Date.

Declined Invitations

If an invitation is declined for any reason, including a failure to timely register and pay the registration fee:

1. Centurion and Supreme Boats may, but is not required to, offer that invitation to the next ranked and otherwise qualified competitor in the Division in which the invitation was declined; or
2. Centurion and Supreme Boats may, but is not required to, allocate any declined invitation to any other Division, and invite the next ranked and otherwise qualified competitor in that Division.
